1 The Secretary of State for Defence between the 27th day of February and the 20th day of March 1974 in accordance with Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 caused to be deposited with the Oxfordshire County Council map(s) of certain Establishments vested in the said Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council together with a statement indicating what ways (if any) over that land the said Secretary of State admitted to have been dedicated as highways

2 No additional way (other than the way(s) described in the Schedule herein contained and indicated on the plan annexed to this Declaration) over the land delineated on the maps so deposited with the Oxfordshire County Council has been dedicated as a highway since the 20th day of March 1974
