1 The Secretary of State for Defence between the 27th day of February 1974 and the 20th day of March 1974 and on the 5th day of December 1977 in accordance with Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 caused to be deposited with the Oxfordshire County Council maps of certain Establishments vested in the said Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council together with a statement indicating what ways over that land the said Secretary of State admitted to have been dedicated as highways

2 No additional way over the land delineated on the maps so deposited with the Oxfordshire County Council has been dedicated as a highway since the 22nd day of November 1977 being the date of the lodgement in accordance with the said Section of a previous Declaration made in respect of the said land AND I MAKE this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835
