

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, Herbert William James Morrell, DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

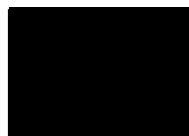
1. I am and have been since 29th November 1946 the owner of the above land known as the Culham Estate more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 16th September 1995 I deposited with the Oxford County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways and the ways coloured yellow on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 16th September 1995 referred to in 2. above.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 11th day of October 1995 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
