

STATUTORY DECLARATION
SECTION 31(6) of the HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

We, Mrs TM Ponsonby and Lord de Mauley DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY
DECLARE as follows:

1. We are the owners of the land known as Little Faringdon Lake, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red.
2. On the day 16th day of May, 2007 we deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that there are no routes or ways over our property which have been dedicated as highways or public rights of way of any kind.
3. No highways or public rights of way have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 14th July 2007 referred to in paragraph 2. above and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any public rights of way over our property.
