

STATUTORY DECLARATION

SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I Nicholas Johnston DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been since 1997 the owner of the land known as Part Great Tew Estate (Great Tew Limited) more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged and hatched pink.
2. On the 11th day of February 2009 I deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by edging and hatching in pink which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status the ways coloured blue on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways the ways coloured pink on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths (there are none) no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged and hatched pink on the map accompanying this declaration since the statement dated referred to in 2 above other than those marked in the appropriate colour on the map accompanying this declaration and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 11th day of MAY 2009. conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
