**STATUTORY DECLARATION**

**SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

I Roger Maingot as trustee of the Berkshire Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire Wildlife Trust DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:


1. I am and have been since 1979 the owner of the land known as Dry Sandford Pit more particularly delineated on the map accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 1st day of November 2010 I deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a map delineating my property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said map and on the map accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as byways open to all traffic no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 26 October 2010 referred to in (2) above and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 14th day of February 2011 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
