

4. On the 14 January 1993 Mr Wasbrough and the then trustees of the 1984 Settlement and the 1992 Settlement deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a Statement dated 13 January 1993 ("the Statement") accompanied by three plans numbered 1, 2 and 3. Subject to minor variations which do not affect the present purposes of this declaration the land edged red on the said plan number 1 is the same as the land edged red on the Exhibited Plan, the land edged red on the said plan number 2 is the same as the land edged orange on the Exhibited Plan, and the land edged red on the said plan number 3 is the same as the land edged blue on the Exhibited Plan.
5. In the Statement it was stated that:
  - (a) the public has a right of way over the footpaths and bridleways which are marked purple and green respectively on the plans numbered 1 and 2 attached to the Statement and coloured brown and green on the Exhibited Plan and that the public does not have any right of way over the land shown edged red on the plan numbered 3 attached to the Statement (which is shown edged blue on the Exhibited Plan)
  - (b) the public has a right of way over the byway open to all traffic or road used as a public path which is marked by a broken green line on the plan numbered 2 attached to the Statement and by a purple line on the Exhibited Plan
  - (c) The public does not have any other right of way over the land which is shown edged red on the plans numbered 1, 2 and 3 attached to the Statement and edged red orange and blue on the Exhibited Plan
6. On the 7 January 1999 Mr Wasbrough and the then trustees of the 1984 Settlement and the 1992 Settlement deposited with Oxfordshire County Council a further statement (as a Statutory Declaration) under S.31(6) Highways Act 1980 stating that no additional ways had been dedicated over the land shown edged red, orange and blue on the Exhibited Plan since the Statement dated 13 January 1993 and that at the then present time Mr Wasbrough and the then trustees of the 1984 Settlement and the 1992 Settlement had no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over their respective properties.
7. It is now confirmed that no additional ways have been dedicated over the land shown edged red, orange and blue on the Exhibited Plan since the Statement dated 13 January 1993 and at the present time we, Mr Wasbrough, Mr Wigmore, and Mr Barlow, have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our respective properties.
